

Changes to Montpelier Health Centre and Bath Buildings

The next time you visit us you will notice some changes to our look and layout.

These have been put in place as both practices are becoming busier, and this allows us to continue to see more patients safely and for our team here to feel safe also.

We ask all patients to acknowledge the social distancing signage which is in place.

Here's the kind of things you will see:



We can only allow a certain number of patients into the waiting room at any one time, so please, where possible, attend the health centre on your own.

But if that's not possible, or if you are attending with someone who needs support or if you are attending with a child, only 1 person should attend with the patient.

If you are coming inside, you will be allowed in once it is safe to do so and you will then see floor stickers showing you where you should stand until you are called forward. Prior to this you will be triaged at the door to check it safe for you to come inside. We will ask you some health related questions and take your temperature.

You will also notice both our reception desks and our Patient Services Manager and Reception Clerk windows have clear shielding guards in place; these are to protect you and our staff.
